*Does anyone have a recommendation for a breath alcohol testing device?*

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Here at ExxonMobil we use the RBT Intoximeter by Intoximeter INC. Their phone number is ( 314-241-1158.) We have been using this type for 20+ years and easy to use and calibrate. They also provide training and equipment maintenance.

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I have used the Alcotest 6810 by Drager Safety. We had a great instructor that made it fun and easy to learn & use. This can be utilized for DOT or Non-Dot screenings. I don't have the telephone number here at home, however, if you are interested you can send me an email at work and I can get you the information you need. I am in the process of purchasing this same device for random testing at my current place of employment.
